#### **Associate Membership**

### Student Membership

Open to graduate and undergraduate college or university students enrolled full-time in any program or part-time in a translation- or interpreting-related program, including foreign language study.

- Student members cannot list their services in the Language Services
   Directory.
- Requires proof of current student enrollment (in English).
- Membership is limited to 4 years.

## ATA Membership for Organizations

## **Corporate Membership**

Membership is in the name of the corporation, not of an individual.

- Corporate members receive the benefit of listing their services in the *Language Services Directory*.
- Employees of Corporate members are not eligible to take the ATA certification examination unless they are also individual members.

## **Institutional Membership**

Membership is in the name of the institution, not of an individual.

- Institutional members cannot list their services in the Language Services Directory.
- Employees of Institutional members are not eligible to take the ATA certification examination unless they are also individual members.
- · Proof of nonprofit status is required.
